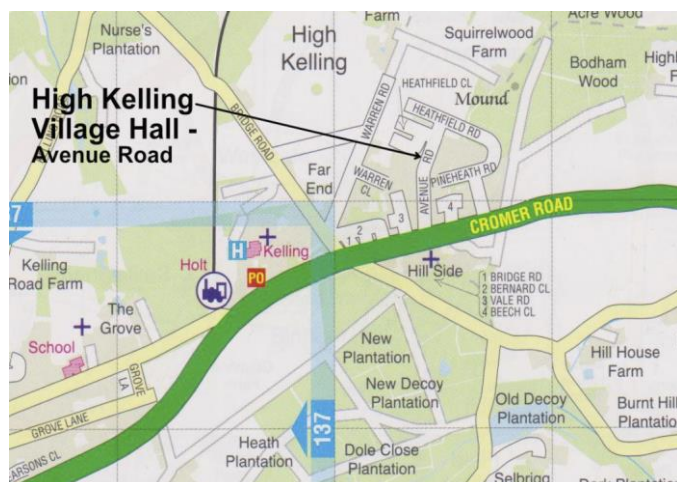
The u3a is described as 'a university in the older, original sense of people coming together for the pleasure of learning and sharing knowledge'.

Our aim is to learn together and exchange information and experiences on all things connected with digital photography, particularly camera operation and software techniques.

Our members encompass all abilities from absolute beginners upwards, so we try to create a program that is varied and interesting.

High Kelling Village Hall is located on Avenue Road and parking is free. There is no need to book - just arrive in good time for your first free session at 2pm for 2:15pm.



Our Meetings.

During the first half of each meeting members can show up to 4 photos on a given subject, which changes each month. We use the HKVH overhead projector for screening, so there are no printing costs.

There are no competitions and no judgements are made. Contributors are encouraged to tell us a little about their efforts and how they achieved them - the whole emphasis is on learning and enabling each of us to get the most from our fascinating and enthralling hobby.



Each member chooses their own favourite which is later loaded onto the U3A website for that month. After all the images have been shown we have a coffee/tea break with biscuits and much chat.

The second period usually includes a demonstration of some aspect of software or picture improvement/techniques followed by a general question and answer session where any subject can be covered and expanded on.

Camera Clinics.

From time to time we also have 'Camera Clinics' where we split into groups, each based on a specific camera brand or genre. This enables us to concentrate on specific issues relevant to that range of cameras so we can exchange information important to individual members.

There is no enrolment fee and your first meeting is free. Then, if you decide to join us, it's just £3 for each meeting which includes tea or coffee and biscuits. Parking is free too.
